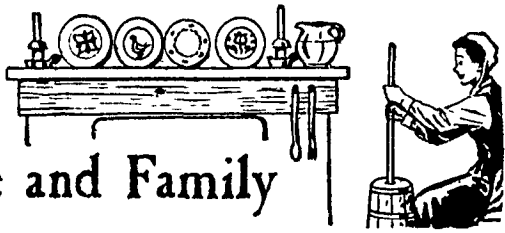

2 cups (1 pound can) cream-style corn
Chopped parsley

In a large saucepan melt butter, saute onion and celery until lightly browned. Add potatoes and milk, cover and sim-

mer over low heat about 30 minutes, or until potatoes are done. Stir in Cheddar cheese until melted, add corn. Serve hot, with a sprinkling of parsley over each serving 4 to 6 servings.

Creamy fish bisques and chowders are popular family dishes -- and wonderful for getting more milk in your menus. You spend so little time in making them, yet can rest assured your family's getting the nutrients essential to good health. A satisfying creamy-thick Salmon Bisque can serve as lunch's main dish accompanied by crunchy-fresh carrot strips and tub-ried dishes. Hungry appetites might enjoy a butter-grilled or solden

baked cheese sandwich to the customary buttered crackers.

SALMON BISQUE

- 1/4 cup (1/2 stick) butter
- 1/2 cup finely chopped onion
- 1/3 cup finely chopped green pepper
- 1/2 cup finely chopped celery
- 3-4 tablespoons flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1 quart milk
- 1 can (7-1/2 ounce) salmon, drained
- 2 tablespoons chopped pimiento

Melt butter in saucepan. Saute onion, green pepper and celery until lightly browned. Add flour, salt and pepper, mixing to a smooth paste. Cook over medium heat about

1 minute. Remove from heat and add one-half of the milk, stirring until blended. Return to heat and stir constantly until mixture begins to thicken. Add remaining milk. Heat to simmering point, cook about 5 minutes. Add salmon, broken into chunks, and pimiento. Heat to serving temperature. 4-6 servings.

Don't ever worry about left-over turkey. You can put it in sandwiches, in casseroles and stews, soups and salads. There is nothing more tasty than turkey chowder, serve it with hot rolls and a crisp tossed salad.

TURKEY CHOWDER

- 2 slices bacon, chopped
- 1/2 cup chopped onion
- 1 cup diced celery
- 2 cups cubed potatoes
- 1 cup diced cooked turkey
- 2 cups turkey broth
- 1 cup whole kernel corn
- 2 tablespoons chopped parsley
- 2 tablespoons flour
- 1 cup milk
- Salt and pepper

Place bacon in fry pan over low heat. When part of the fat has cooked out, add the onion. Continue cooking until onion is soft and bacon is brown. Meanwhile, cook celery, potatoes and turkey in broth until the vegetables are tender. Then add corn, cooked bacon, onion and parsley. Blend flour with milk and stir into cooking mix-
