

If your clothes aren't coming out of the washer as sparkling white as you'd like perhaps you didn't do a good job of sorting them. For best results sort clothes for color-fastness, degree of soil and type of fabric.

When you water house plants water until the moisture runs to the bottom of the pot. Wait a few minutes and add the same amount again. Never allow the plants to wilt or the soil to dry out completely.

Five new members were inducted into the club. Paul G. Sites, Manheim R2, was elected in adult leader in the club.

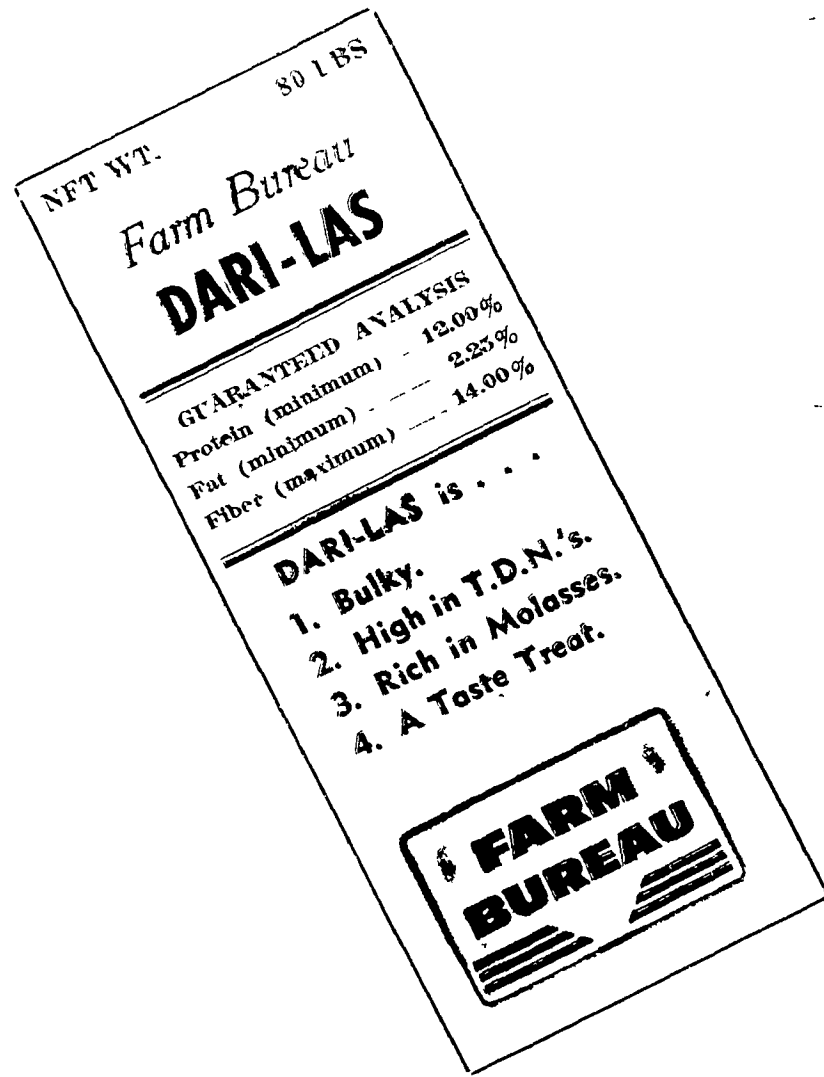
