Di C William Pierce agricultural economist from Pennsylvania State University laid the groundwork for the meeting by discussing and analyring the history of Pennsylvania's Wilk Control Law Di Pieice noted that Pennsylvania dairy farmer income has increased at a faster rate than has dairy farmer income in adjacent states On the other hand statistics show fair milk prices have been maintained, for Pennsylvania consumers

The group generally agreed that milk control has been a vital force in assuring adequate price levels for producers and fair prices for consumers in Pennsylvania The decision to endorse continuation of milk control by the group, (representing thousands of dury farmers and milk dealers), was based upon the "long range stabilizing effects of the law on all segments of the economy"

Further study was recommended to pinpoint benefits of milk control and to consider possible changes in the law or its administration. It was recognized some changes might be necessary to keep pace with economic and technological developments in the industry




