**Four Holsteins From County In Nat'l Sale**

Four Holstein dairy animals from three Lancaster County farms have been consigned to the national sale held in conjunction with the 77th national convention of the Holstein-Friesian Association of America

Selling at the June 7 auction in Roanoke, Virginia will be two females from the herd of J Mowery Frey, Fultonway Farms, Lancaster R7; one female from the herd of Melvin G Peifer, Willow Street and

one female from the herd of Mr and Mrs. Herbert Royer, 2025 Oregon Pike, Lancaster

A total of 82 head have been consigned to the sale, according to George A Miller, Rokey Mount Virginia, chairman of the sale committee. Six young bulls and 76 cows and heifers are listed in the sale offering. According to Miller, the offspring of 34 Gold Medal Sires and 23 Silver Medal Sires are included among the consignments.

Eighteen of the sale animals are progeny of cows with lifetime records of more than 100,000 lbs of milk.

In terms of type, or body conformation, 45 of the animals selling have at least one parent classified "Excellent" the highest designation in the official Holstein Association program.

Sixty registered Holstein cows and bulls with offspring selling are scored in the second highest "Very Good" bracket.

More than 1,500 dairy industry leaders from throughout the Western Hemisphere are expected to be in Roanoke for the four-day convention

program. The schedule opens June 4 on the VPI campus at Blacksburg, moves to the Hotel Roanoke for two days of business sessions, June 5 and 6, and closes with the sale.

**Broiler Advisory Makes Report**

The Stabilization Advisory Committee on Broilers, adjourned today after a two day meeting in Washington, D C, to review a draft of a program proposal to stabilize the industry and request that the Committee be in 60 days.

The committee discussed provisions of a draft proposal it had requested USDA attorneys to draft at its last session on May 7-8 which reflected committee recommendations to stabilize the broiler industry.

The committee also discussed other recommendations and modifications which were suggested for inclusion in the draft proposal but failed to conclude its review of the program draft and recommendations submitted by members.
