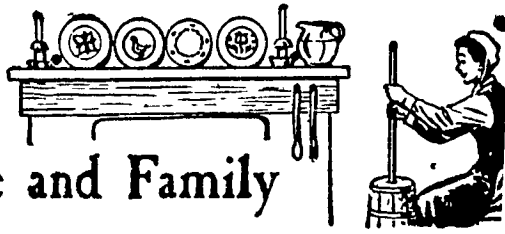

"PUNCH" FOR JUNE

When the month of June finds its page turned up on the calendar, it always means there will be parties galore—end-of-school parties, commencement parties and showers and parties for the bride.

One of the biggest problems for these affairs is something refreshing to drink. We think you'll like these easy-to-make punches we have for you today.

FRUIT 'N' SHERBET PUNCH

- 1 pint lemon sherbet
- 6 ounce can frozen concentrated orange juice
- 6 ounce can frozen concentrated pineapple juice
- 1 pint cranberry cocktail
- Red food coloring
- 2 cups gingerale

In punch bowl reconstitute orange and pineapple juices according to directions on cans. Add cranberry cocktail and enough red food coloring to obtain a deeper red. Just before serving add ginger ale. Float scoops of lemon sherbet on top. 15 to 18 servings.

PARTY PUNCH

- 2 6-ounce cans frozen orange juice thawed
- 1 6-ounce cans frozen limeade thawed
- 2 6-ounce cans frozen lemonade thawed
- 1 quart pineapple juice
- 1 pint cranberry juice cocktail
- 2 quarts water

- Few drops red and yellow food coloring
- Water
- Gingerale

Mix orange juice, limeade, lemonade, pineapple juice, cranberry juice cocktail 2 quarts water, and food coloring. Use this mixture as a base for punch. To mix punch use 2 quarts of base, 1 quart of water and 2 quarts gingerale (add gingerale just before serving). 50 servings.

PINEAPPLE LEMONADE

- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup boiling water
- 1 cup lemon juice
- 5 cups ice water
- 2 cups crushed pineapple
- Ice cubes

Add sugar to boiling water, stir until dissolved. Pour in lemon juice and ice water. Add crushed pineapple. Chill thoroughly in tightly sealed jar. Strain (optional) and serve over ice cubes. Makes 12 servings.

ORANGEADE

- 3 cups fresh orange juice
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 3 cups cold water
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice

Combine lemon juice and sugar in pitcher, stirring to dissolve sugar. Add water and lemon juice. Pour into glasses filled with ice cubes. Garnish with orange slices. Makes 1 1/2 quarts.

"MAKE AHEAD" LEMONADE

- 3 cups lemon juice
- 2 1/2 cups sugar

Combine lemon juice and sugar. Stir until sugar dissolves. Keep in the refrigerator. When ready to use add to in a covered glass containing approximately two trays of ice cubes and 3 1/2 qts. (14 cups) of water. Makes 1 gallon.

GOLDEN PUNCH

- 3 cups water
- 2 cups sugar
- 4 sticks cinnamon
- 1 tablespoon whole cloves
- 2 cups pineapple juice
- 2 cans reconstituted orange juice

Combine water, sugar, cinnamon and cloves in saucepan. Place over low heat and boil for 5 minutes. Strain and cool. Add pineapple juice, orange juice and lemon juice. When ready to serve, add 2 quarts ginger ale and ice cubes. Makes 20 servings.

FRUIT FLIP

- 1 10-ounce package frozen sliced strawberries
 - 6-ounce can frozen lemonade concentrate
 - 2 cups apricot nectar
 - Crushed ice
- Thaw and drain strawberries and combine with lemonade concentrate. Add apricot nectar, blending until well mixed. Pour over crushed ice to serve. Makes 1 8-ounce servings.

ORANGE BERRY COOLER

- 1 orange sectioned
- 1/2 of a 10-ounce package frozen raspberries, thawed
- 1/2 cup cold milk
- Vanilla ice cream

Blend orange sections, frozen raspberries and cold milk in blender until smooth. Pour into 4 tall glasses. Add 2 scoops of vanilla ice cream, orange sections and raspberries (from remaining 1/2 package) to each glass. Fill glasses with orange soda. Makes 4 servings.

SPICED AMBER DRINK

- 1 quart boiling water
 - 8 tea bags
 - 1/4 teaspoon nutmeg
 - 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon
 - 1/4 teaspoon allspice
 - 6-ounce can pineapple lemon concentrate
 - 6-ounces water
- Pour boiling water over tea bags, add spices. Let steep for 5 minutes. Remove teabags, cool and strain. Combine pineapple lemon concentrate with water. Add to tea. Makes 5 8-ounce servings.

APRICOT FIZZ

- 1 1/2 cups (12 ounce can) apricot nectar
 - 1 pint ginger ale or sparkling water, chilled
 - 1 pint vanilla ice cream




