**Broilers Remain Steady**

Broiler prices at the Lancaster Poultry Center this week continued just about the same with the previous week. A total of 20 lots of broilers were sold at prices ranging from 16 to 17 1/2 for a sale of 16 2/5. Most of the sales were made with about a quarter of the birds sold went to 17. All broilers on offer were sold. A lot of 800 cockerels at 16 weeks two days were not sold at the bid of 16, and one lot of black and silver cross at 16 weeks failed to sell at the 19 cent bid. A lot of 450 silver cross was sold at 23 1/2, and two lots of 100 heavy pullets at 22 1/2 and 22 1/2. A heavy toml brought 14 to 16 for the 2,765 head in lots. Four lots containing 15 leghorn fowl sold for 9 1/2; while 222 males in 4 lots brought 7 1/2 to 7 1/4. The complete June 7 auction offered 91,082 head in lots and sold \$9,882 head in 34 lots. One lot of leghorn was withdrawn prior to sale and one lot of White ducks failed to get a buyer.

**Delmarva-Georgia Prices Gain, Demand Good**

Live broiler prices in Delmarva averaged slightly higher during the 24 hour period ending 10 30 Friday morning with a good demand meeting the moderate offerings. Prices and reported purchases at the farms during the period ranged 15 1/2 to 16 1/2 for 850 200 head including 525 700 head purchased at the Eastern Shore Poultry Producers Exchange Thursday. Estimated slaughter by eastern shore processors for the week end was 872 000 head compared to the 791 000 head last week end. The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending June 1 was up one point from the previous week at 3 1/2. Broilers averaged 16 24 per pound and mash cost the grower \$94 85 per ton.

**Fluid Milk Supplies Light, Demand Fair**

Fluid milk production declined slightly in most areas, remained unchanged to slightly improved in areas where pasture conditions improved. Bottling demand ranged fair to good with Pennsylvania and Georgia reporting lighter needs as schools closed for the summer. Wholesale selling price of bottling quality milk in New York ranged from \$1 30 to \$4 10 per 40 quart unit.

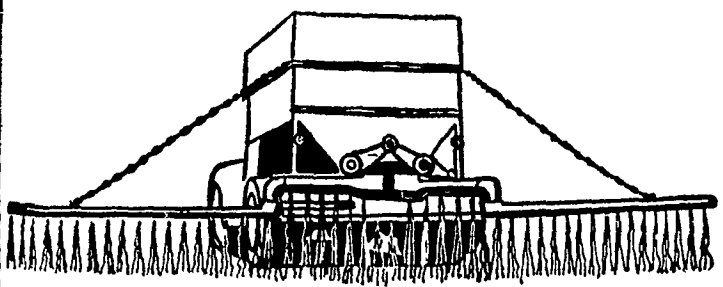


