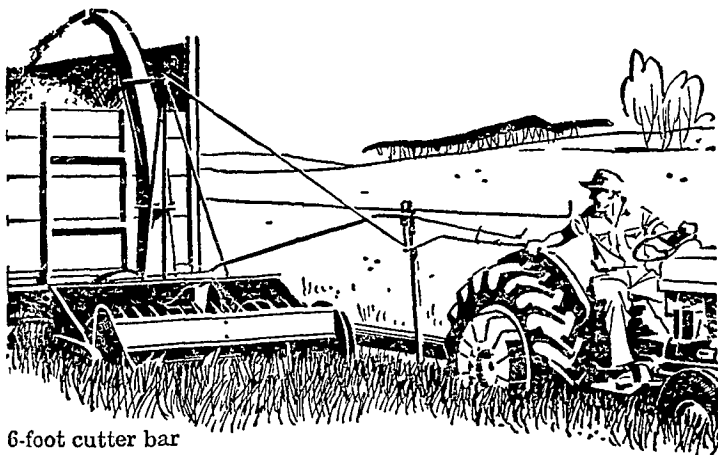

Tina's record of 18070 lbs. of milk and 754 lbs of butterfat, actual, was produced entirely on twice-a-day milking and did not exceed 305 days in length. It was supervised by the Division of Records of the Ayrshire Breeders' Association, Brandon, Vermont, and the Penna. State Univ, Univ Park. M H. Royal Tina has an unusually persistent lactation record, having a daily average of 59 lbs. milk and 24 lbs. butterfat
