

**PENN SQUARE MUTUAL FUND DECLARES DIVIDEND**

The Board of Trustees of Penn Square Mutual Fund today declared a dividend from net investment income of 8 cents per share, payable July

27 to shareholders of record July 2, according to Ronald L. Sweitzer, secretary of the board.

Thus far in 1962, distributions total \$111, with 28 cents being paid from net investment income, 76 cents

from long-term capital gains, and 7 cents from short-term capital gains

In the comparable period of 1961, the total distribution was \$161, Sweitzer said

Jacob L. Hain, Chairman of the Fund, announced that total net assets of Penn Square were \$30,972,682 as of June 30, 1962, an increase of 32% over the \$20,926,471 as of June 30, 1961. The total shares outstanding on June 30, 1962 were 2,616,344, compared with 1,376,692 on June 30, 1961. Total net assets on December 31, 1961 amounted to \$30,472,133, and there were 1,902,733 shares outstanding
