

LANCASTER POULTRY CENTER All Birds Are Sold

All lots offered were sold at the Thursday, July 5 auction at the Lancaster Poultry Center.

Broilers gained almost a cent a pound over the previous week as 56,400 head in 15 lots brought prices of 16 to 16 3/4. Most of the sales were at 16 3/4. Last week's sale average was 15 4/9.

The sale average at the comparable sale last year was 14 7/8 when 39,700 head ranged from 14 1/2 to 15 1/8.

At Thursday's auction only five lots, other than broilers, were on sale. One lot of 2,000 Leghorn fowl brought 9 7/8 while 6,200 roasters in four lots changed hands at 21 0 to 22 7/8.

The sale offered and sold a total of 64,600 head in 20 lots. The highest priced lot was a lot of 650 White Vantress Cockerels at 13 weeks and two days of age. They were consigned by Miller and

Bushong, and John Herr, and were purchased by W C Mellinger and Son for 22 7/8 cents per pound. The high lot of broilers was the 1,500 White Vantress at 9 weeks and six days, consigned by Daniel B King and purchased by Carl B Risser for 16 7/8 cents a pound.

Delmarva-Georgia Supply Heavy; Prices Gain

Live prices advanced under a good demand for the heavy offerings. Prices advanced nearly one half cent to 15 2 to 16 4 during the 24 hour period ending at 10 30 Friday morning.

At fair prices were on sale of 1,073,300 head including 636,800 head sold Thursday at the Eastern Shore Poultry Exchange. Almost half the sales were at 15 5 to 15 9.

With most dressing plants operating near capacity, and ready to cook demand continuing good, Eastern Shore processors estimated slaughter for the week end at 861,000 head compared to the 752,000 head last week end.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending June 29 was down one point at 3 2. Broilers averaged 15 00 and mash cost the grower \$93 68 per ton.

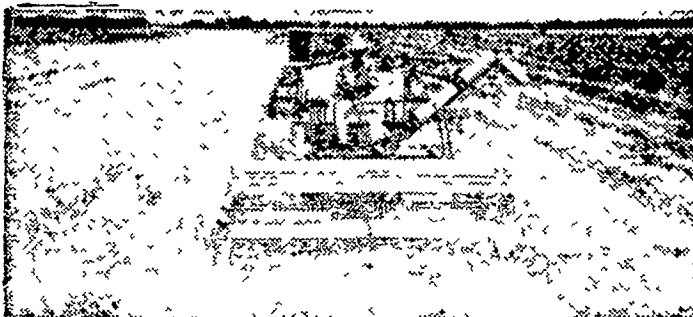
