Moss on lawns is usually a sign of low fertility, poor drainage, improper watering, too much shade, or a combination of these factors. John C. Harper II, Penn State extension agronomist, suggests removing the moss by hand raking, or by spraying with copper sulfate. Apply at the rate of five ounces in four gallons of water per 1,000 square feet. After the moss is removed, correct the cause.

NEW YORK, N. Y. A new corporation, Hubbard Euro-Poultry, S. A., with headquarters and poultry plant at

Oudenaarde, Belgium, has been established by Hubbard Farms and Euro-Poultry for European Common Market distribution of its breeding stock.

The corporation, jointly owned by Hubbard Farms and Euro-Poultry will carry out foundation breeding lines on its poultry farms at Oudenaarde, Belgium, and supply parent stock to franchise distributors in each of the Common Market countries.

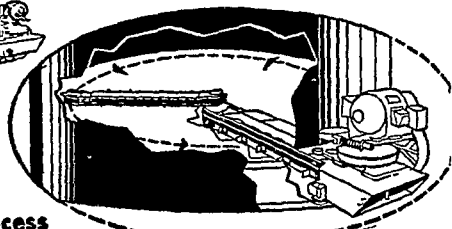
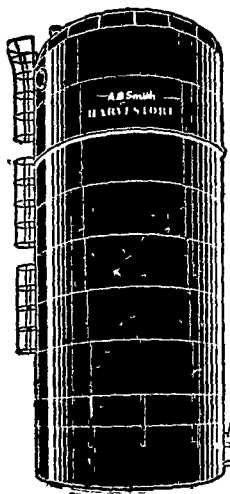

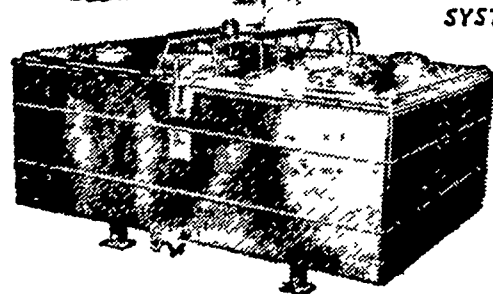
