8 medium

- 1 medium onion sliced and sliced
- 1/2 pound fresh mushrooms, sliced
- 1/4 cup (1/2 stick) butter
- 1 10-1/2-ounce can condensed cream of mushroom soup
- 1 cup milk
- 2 teaspoons salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper

In casserole, alternate layers of potatoes, onion, carrots and mushrooms. Dot layers with butter. Combine soup, milk, salt and pepper, pour over vegetables. Cover, bake 1 hour in a 350 degree oven. Uncover, bake 30 minutes longer or until done.

ZIPPY DIP FOR GARDEN VEGETABLES

- 1 cup cottage cheese
- 1 3-ounce package cream cheese
- 1 teaspoon prepared horseradish
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- Few drops of Tabasco sauce

1/4 cup chopped fresh dill
In a blender or mixer, beat together cottage and cream
4 medium carrots peeled
cheeses, horseradish, salt and
Tabasco sauce until smooth
and fluffy. Blend in dill.
Serve in a hollowed-out cu-
cumber, if desired. Use as a
dip for vegetables.

TANGY SOUR CREAM

- 2 cups dairy sour cream
- 3-4 tablespoons prepared horseradish
- 2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce
- 1 teaspoon celery seed
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon paprika
- 4 teaspoons finely chopped pimiento olives

Blend sour cream with remaining ingredients thoroughly. Chill several hours. Serve as a dip for garden vegetables.

CHEESEY CREAM DIP

- 1 pint dairy sour cream
- 1-1/2 cups shredded sharp Cheddar cheese
- 1/4 cup sliced stuffed green olives
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon sage

Blend above ingredients together and use as a dip for either chips or vegetables. Makes 3 cups.

STUFFED CELERY

- 3/4 cup cottage cheese
 - 1 3-ounce package cream cheese
 - 1-1/2 teaspoon salt
- Combine cheeses and salt. Fill centers of celery pieces with mixture; sprinkle with seasoned salt. Chill before serving. Makes 1 cup.

ener restores fluffiness and softness in articles you wash. Added to the final rinse water, fabric softener forms a coating on the surface of every fiber. This coating reduces static electricity in fabrics of man-made fibers, softens baby clothes, and fluffs terry robes and chenille bedspreads. Fabric softener is sold under several brand names. Follow the directions on the container for its use. Because softener makes fabric less absorbent, use it sparingly on dish towels and bath towels.

ABOUT WOOD FLOORS

Wood floors will last longer if you wax them regularly. Do it every four to six months. If you have young children and the floors get a lot of traffic, you'll want to touch up some spots between the regular waxings.
