New Holland reported a slow cow market and prices \$15 to \$30 per head lower at the July 11 auction of dairy cattle. Two hundred cows, six bulls and 11 heifers were in the run.
 Fresh Holstein cows brought \$250-375 while Guernseys sold at \$175-235 and other breeds brought \$175-225. Stock bulls were \$140-160 and stock heifers brought \$65-150.
 At the July 9 sale of horses, ponies and mules, 239 head crossed the block at steady prices and active trading.
 Mare ponies brought \$75-125 while geldings sold at \$40-120. Riding horses were \$140-275 and driving horses brought \$130-275. Killers were 8 1/2 to 9 cents per pound.
 At the July 9 hog auction 435 head sold on a steady market. Retail hogs to local butchers brought 20 5 to 21 35 while number 1-3 hogs brought 19 5 to 20 5. Heavy, fat hogs over 240 pounds sold for 18 5 to 19 5.
 The July 9 calf auction saw 151 head sold at prices 1 00 higher than the previous week. Choice and prime vealers brought 34-38 good and low choice 31-34 and standard and low good 25-31. Cull and common brought 18-25. Choice spring lambs sold for 20 5-23.
