Two 4-H Teams Pass District Competition

ALLENTOWN - Four Lancaster County 4-H members presented winning demonstrations in the Southeast Penna. district competition Tuesday to earn the right to take their presentations to the state finals later this summer. The four members, two boys representing agriculture clubs and two girls representing local home economics clubs, made up two demonstration teams which last week won county competition to move into the district contest.

The county's two winning demonstrations, presented at the Allentown Fair Grounds, were:

Forestry: Jay Lehman, fourteen, a son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert N. Lehman, Holtwood R1, and Robert Henry, fifteen, a son of Mr. and Mrs. Raymond K. Henry, New Providence R1.

Clothing Selection: Miss Belinda Hershey, fifteen, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Nelson Hershey, Manheim, and Miss Marcella White, seventeen, a daughter of Mr. and

Mrs. Stanley White, Manheim R3.

The forestry demonstration, stressed the proper planting of evergreens. The clothing topic was "Fabrics and You."

A third county team featuring the preparation of garden flowers for the home missed a championship performance by one point.

The team was composed of Miss Joan Flickinger, Ephrata R3 and Miss Pat Zartman, Ephrata R1.

A total of 86 agriculture and home economics teams from 13 counties competed for a crack at the state finals, scheduled during the Pennsylvania 4-H Judging and Demonstration Days, Aug. 13-15, at Pennsylvania State University.

It's easy to keep salad bowls or other wood pieces as beautiful as the day you got them, say Penn State extension home economics specialists. Right after use, wipe off each piece with a soft cloth or sponge and warm suds. Rinse with cold water and dry thoroughly -- never soak woodenware in water. Whenever you buy wood items, check the label for washing instructions. Keep woodenware away from heat and store it in a dry place.

Conservation Field Day Features Tours

Wagon tours will take visitors to spots of interest on Speedwell Forge Farm during the third annual Conservation Field Day on Wednesday.

Wagons will begin rolling about 10 a.m. on the Lutz R2 farm of Gerald Darlington. Demonstrations and exhibits will be open to the public all day, and many agencies cooperating with the county Soil Conservation District will have displays on the farm.

County teachers of vocational agriculture will conduct the wagon tours which will include stops at areas of wildlife plantings, marked forestry plots, contour cropping, tile drainage diversion terraces and other conservation practices.

Ladies of the Coleman Memorial Presbyterian Church will have a food stand in the vicinity of the buildings near the site of the educational exhibits.

The farm is located one mile north of Penryn. Directional signs will be placed on Route 501 just north of Lutz and on route 322 just west of Buckerville.

Ventilating Fan

Use the ventilating fan in your kitchen when you're doing any top-of-the-range cooking, suggests Helen Bell, Penn State extension home management specialist. A tin pan, the oven, or almost any cooking utensil generates odors and some moisture that the fan will remove quickly. Turn on the fan while you're washing dishes to remove moisture. A ventilating fan will do a better job if it's run while moisture is building up instead of trying to clear moisture out of a whole room at once.

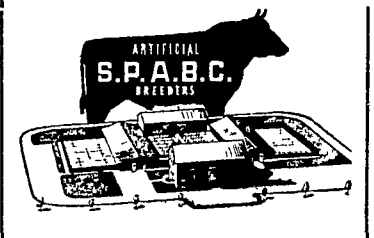
