

LANCASTER POULTRY CENTER Broilers Off Quarter Cent

Broiler prices slipped slightly more than a quarter cent during the week at the Lancaster Poultry Center. Prices at the August 2 auction ranged 16.6 to 17.5 for a sale average of 16.83 compared to the average of 17.18 last week.

A total of 85,475 broilers in 19 lots were sold while only lot of 6,800 White Vantress at 8 weeks 2 days remained unsold at the bid of 16.0.

One lot of 600 heavy fowl brought 17.2 while 5,700 head of leghorn fowl in five lots brought 9.3 to 9.6. Two lots containing 2,500 pullets sold at 23.6 and 25.6, and three lots containing 2,000 roasters changed hands at 23.6 to 23.8.

The complete sale offered 103,350 head in 32 lots and sold 96,400 head in 30 lots. The only other lot not selling contained 150 White Mountains at 12 weeks six days and bid to 20.0.

Delmarva Prices Down Fractionally

Live broiler prices declined slightly in Delmarva during the 24 hour period ending 10 30 Friday morning. A barely fair demand met the light offerings.

Ready to cook activity was mostly for heavy birds for feature sales. Estimated slaughter by eastern shore processors for the week end was 825,000 head compared to the 708,300 head last week end.

Prices of 15.9 to 16 7 if farms for \$49,900 head were reported during the period.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending July 27 was up one point from the previous week at 3 5. Broilers averaged 16 71 and mash cost the grower \$94 34 per ton.
