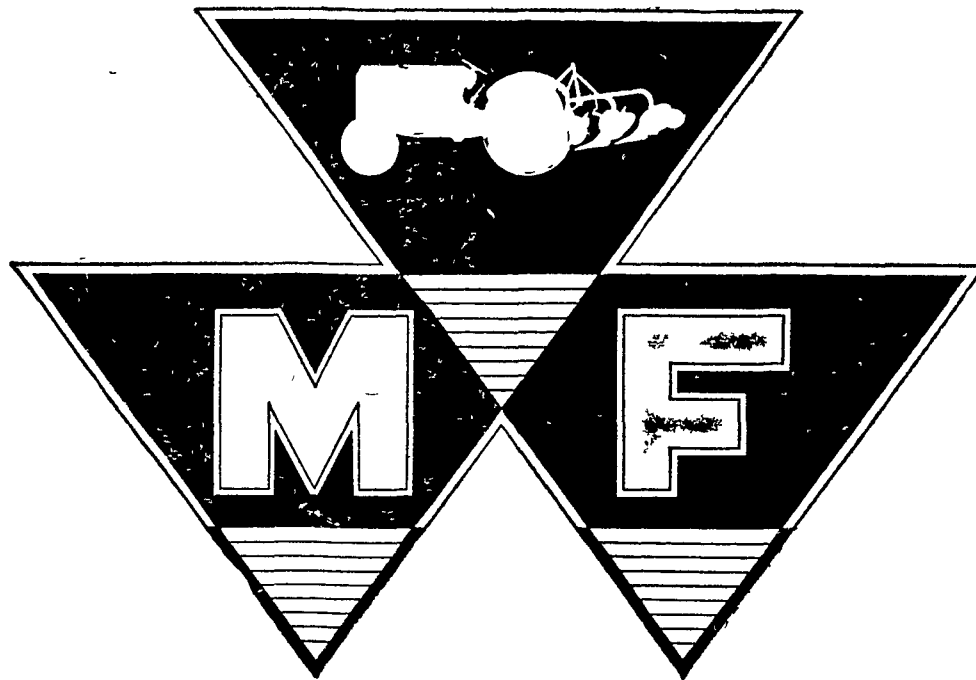

mailed to all farmers in the County on August 24th. Ballots must be returned to the office no later than September 4th.

In addition to the slate of nominees submitted by the Community Committees, nominations may be made by petition. Petitions signed by 10 or more eligible voters, nominating persons for membership on the Community Committee will be received at the County ASCS Office at any time prior to August 15th. Names of persons nominated by proper petition will be included in the slate of nominees if found eligible and willing to serve. If a person nominated is found to be ineligible, he will be notified of such determinations prior to completion of the slate of nominees and may appeal to the County Committee any time prior to August 15th.

In the event an eligible person does not receive a ballot, it may be obtained by contacting the county ASCS office.
