

Zim'erman Herd High in DHIA

A Registered Holstein cow owned by Paul B Zimmerman, R1, Ephrata, completed the highest 305 day lactation. 6 produced 20,021 lbs. of milk, 748 lbs. of butterfat with a 3.7% test. Second high lactation was completed by a Registered Holstein cow owned by Paul E. Nissley, R1, Bainbridge. Pat produced 17,210 lbs. of milk, 740 lbs. of butterfat with a 4.3% test in 305 days.

The herd of Raymond and Louise Witmer, R1, Willow Street, had the highest monthly butterfat average. This herd of 450 Registered Guernsey cows averaged 1,129 lbs of milk, 59 lbs of butterfat with a 5.3% test. The herd of Dan S. Stoltzfus, R1, Mt. Joy,

placed second. This herd of 22.1 Registered Holstein cows averaged 1,459 lbs. of milk, 57 lbs of butterfat with a 3.9% test
