### 4-H Dairy Clubs Hold Joint Meeting

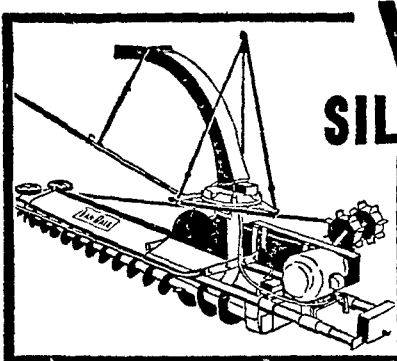
The annual joint meeting of the Three County 4-H Dairy Clubs was held on August 8, at 7 30 p.m. in the Paradise Community Park.

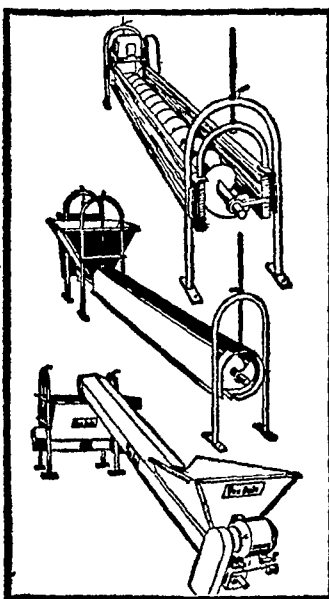
