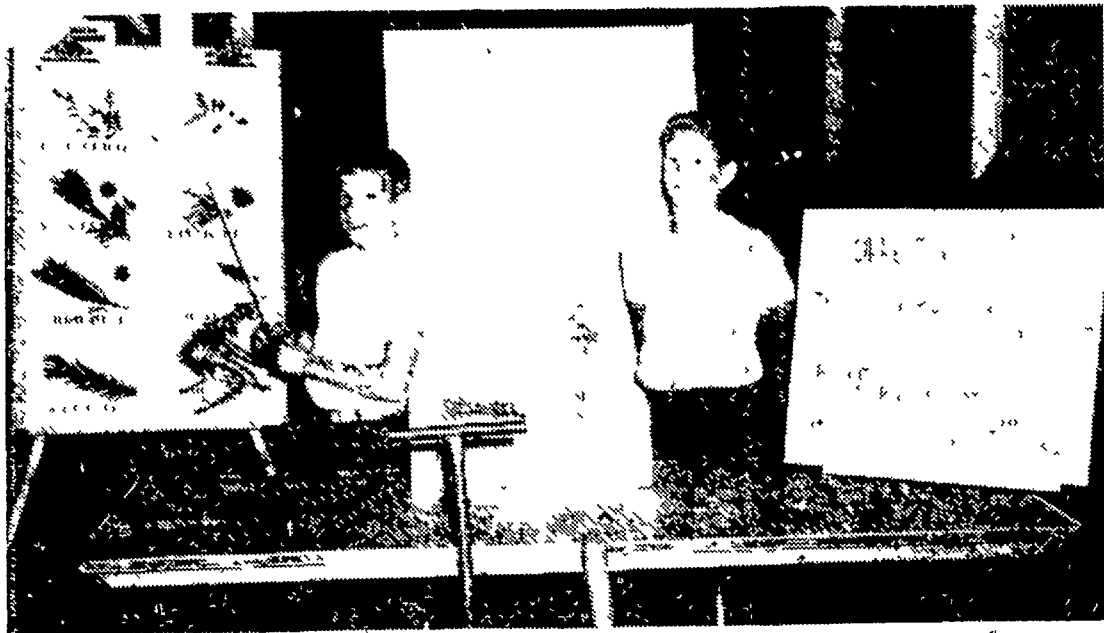

Farmers Urged To Cast Ballot In ASC Election

Fred G Seldomridge, Chairman of the Lancaster County Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Committee issued an appeal to county farmers to vote in the election of ASC county and community committeemen to serve for the 12 month period beginning October 1, 1962 and extending through September 30, 1963.

For each community committee three regular members will be chosen, with the person receiving the highest number of votes becoming chairman. Two alternates also will be elected in each community, to serve in the absence of a regular member. The elected chairman of the community committee will also serve as delegate to the county convention to elect the county committee.

ASC Community Committees will be elected for 1963 in each of the following communities: #1 Conoy, W Donegal & Mt Joy Townships, #2 East Donegal & W Hempfield Townships, #3 Rapho Township, #4 Penn, Warwick & Elizabeth Townships, #5 E Cocalico, W Cocalico,

Brecknock Townships; #6 Caernarvon, E. Earl & Earl Townships, #7. Ephrata, W. Earl & Upper Leacock Townships; #8 Salisbury & Leacock Townships; #9. E. Lampeter, W. Lampeter & Lancaster Townships; #10. Manheim & E Hempfield Townships, #11 Manor, Conestoga & Pequea Townships; #12 Eden, Bart & Sadsbury Townships, #13. Strasburg & Paradise Townships, #14. Martic & Providence Townships, #15 Drumore & E. Diomore Townships; #16. Fulton, Little Britain & Colerain Townships.
