Lenininger, a well known Lancaster County breeder of Spotted hogs, attended the confeience



Evaporated and condensed milk are not new products Buefly, here's what they are and the kind of storage they need

Evaporated milk is a concentrated, sterilized pioduct... it is prepared by heat-ing homogenized whole fluid milk in a vacuum to remove about sixty per cent of the water in whole milk The product is then sealed in cans and sterilized Most evaporated milk sold in stores today has vitamin D added


