TWO COUNTY AGENTS AT NATIONAL MEET

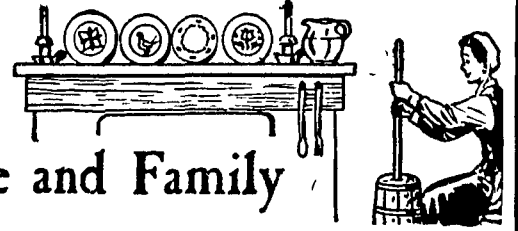
County Agent M. M. Smith and Associate County Agent Victor Plastow are attending the National County Agents Association this week.

Storing Milk In A Can

Evaporated and condensed milk are not new products. Briefly, here's what they are and the kind of storage they need.

Evaporated milk is a concentrated, sterilized product . . . it is prepared by heating homogenized whole fluid milk in a vacuum to remove about sixty per cent of the water in whole milk. The product is then sealed in cans and sterilized. Most evaporated milk sold in stores today has vitamin D added.

Condensed milk, generally has a high sugar content, is also a concentrated milk . . . but it is not sterilized. The forty-two to forty-four per cent sugar content of condensed

ed milk helps to preserve it. The sugar also often makes it unnecessary to use additional sugar when you use condensed milk in cooking or baking.

Canned milk may be kept on the cupboard shelf, but it's better to keep it cool. A forty to sixty degree temperature

is fine for evaporated milk, but condensed milk should be stored at forty degrees for good results.

Both condensed and evaporated milk must be kept in the refrigerator after the cans are opened.
