According to the manufacturers the new process assures correct fit from the start, and means the size will stay constant for the life of the garment. Shrinkage is said to be less than one per

cent. When you shop for cotton knitwear for the men and boys in your family, check the tag for this new shrinkage control process you can put knitwear having this shrinkage control treatment in the washer and dryer knowing it will come out the same size and proportion as when you put it in.
