

GUERNSEY DISPERSAL BRINGS SPIRITED BIDDING

Spirited bidding for the top cows and lively bidding for the rest took 19 head of purebred and grade Guernseys at the Willis G Heri dispersal sale last Saturday.

Top cow, a daughter of Hominy Hill Music Prince, sold for \$450 to Paul Mummett, Chambersburg R5. The same buyer bought her daughter, born in April, for \$110. His purchases amounted to \$1,290 for four head.

The 19 head brought an average of \$279 a head. A two-unit milker sold for \$123.50 and a 200 gallon bulk milk tank brought \$200.
