The Guernsey herd of Francis and Ethel Kirk, Peach Bottom, Pa., has certainly shown a tremendous amount of improvement the last two years. Last year, on DHIA test, the herd increased 1441 lbs. of milk and 82 lbs. of fat, and this year, in the first seven months, the herd average has increased another 40 lbs. of fat. Foregoing any change in the present production, the herd should finish with well over 10,000 lbs. of milk and over 500 lbs. of fat. Their young sire, Carroll's Rob, has been one of the big reasons for this tremendous improvement. He was bred by Lloyd Balderston III, Colora, Maryland.
