Wrap and freeze.

About six months is as long as you will want to keep unbaked fruit pies frozen. Pies will probably be good quality for that long. The freezer space used for pies may be better used for other foods.

*** * *
FREEZE FRUITS
WITHOUT SUGAR**

If you use your supply of

frozen fruits in a few months you may want to put them up without sugar. One advantage of this is that you don't have to guess how much sugar to add when you use them in a recipe. Unsweetened fruits won't keep their high quality for as long as the sugar or syrup pack.

For freezing apples and peaches you will want to take some precaution to keep the fruit from darkening. Lemon juice or citric acid may be

used but neither is a effective as ascorbic acid. Or for apples, you may steam the fruit for a few minutes before packaging. Before you steam the

apples, soak them in a solution of 2 tablespoons salt to a gallon of water for about 20 minutes, then drain. Place slices in a single layer in a

steamer and hold for about 2 minutes. Cool in cold water, drain and pack into freezer containers.
