Judging of the swine show will lead off the Thursday afternoon program at 1 p.m. with the placing of the Beef cattle to follow as soon as the swine have been judged.

Thursday evening's program will include a fashion show at 8 p.m. with a square dance to follow at 9.

The annual baby parade has been scheduled to begin at 10 a.m. on Friday.

New Feature

A new feature has been added to the show schedule this year. An auction sale of the fat hogs and consigned baby beef which have been exhibited will be held at 2 p.m. on Friday.

Following the parade, Professor Schnitzel, the Pennsylvania comedian, will entertain until about 9 p.m. when the Rural Youth awards will be made. Music by a German band will close out the entertainment program.

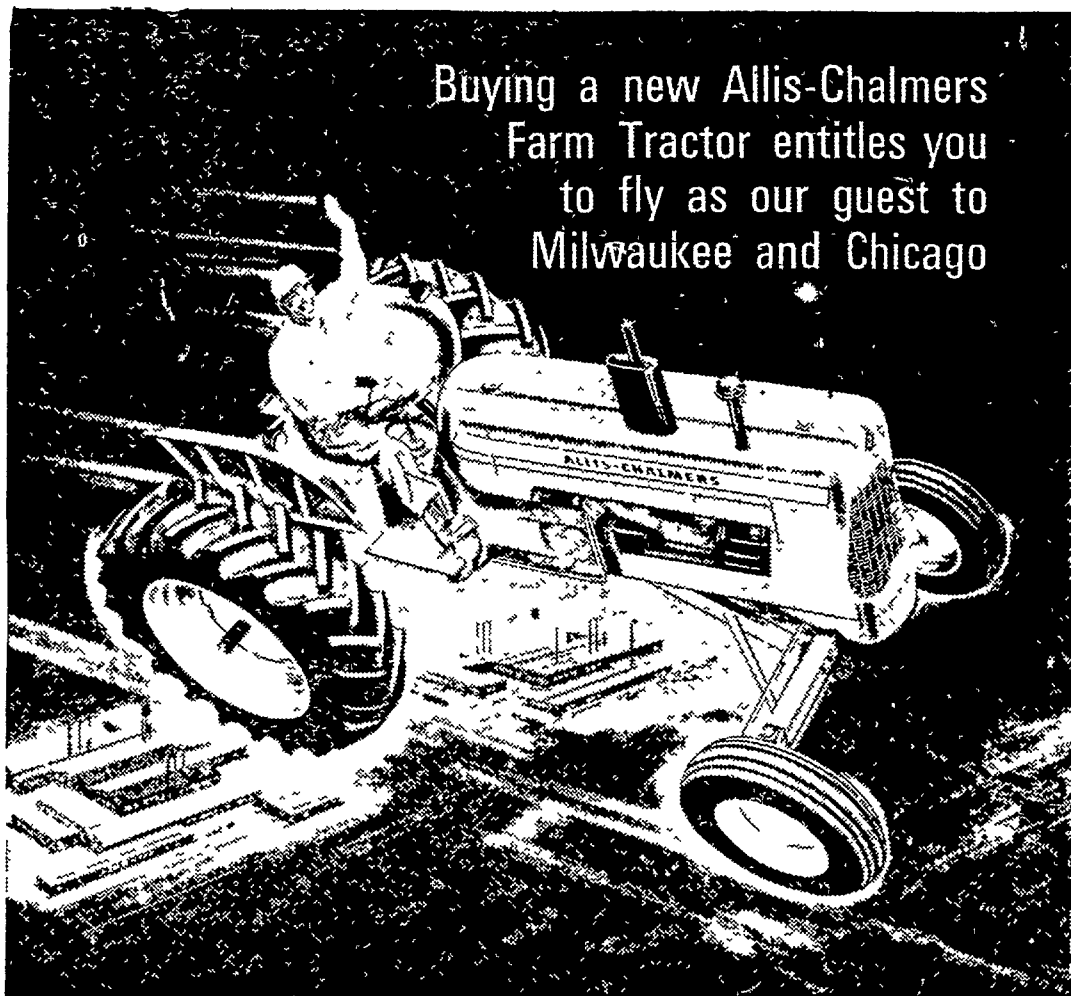
ber 26 and continue through the 28th. The 38th annual exhibition will include a full line of agricultural exhibits, judging and entertainment including a horse show and an antique automobile parade.

During the same three days the Ephrata Fair will have a 4-H beef show and a fancy fowl show along with their street fair and midway.

Manheim Farm Show and New Holland Fair will begin on October 3 with the Manheim association staging a three day exhibit and the New Holland group conducting a four day show.

Manheim will feature a full line of agricultural exhibits including dairy, swine, beef and poultry exhibits, judging and entertainment. The New Holland show features a Corn, Hay and Tobacco show in addition to a baby beef and swine show.
