The other half is used in making ice cream, butter, cheese, nonfat dry milk and many other dairy products

Food economists often compare the proportion of the nation's food supply . . . derived from each commodity group . . . with the proportion of the consumer's dollar spent for each food group. Here's what they find . . . dairy foods rank at the top of this comparison and for this reason . . . while only a fifth of the food dollar is spent for dairy foods, more than a fifth of the total nutrients in the national food supply is derived from dairy foods
