In the Jersey competition, twelve year old Nancy Kreider, Drumore R1, carried away the grand championship rosette with her Senior Calf, Signal Maple Lawn Zonya. She won her first dairy crown by dethroning Marvin Heir, Holtwood R1.

Nancy, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Stanley Kreider, showed her heifer to a first in the class at the Southeast-

ern Pennsylvania Artificial Breeding Cooperative show last month.

Judge Charles Robertson, Schuylkill County Agent commented on the quality of the dairy animals in the all-youth exhibition which saw 20 Guernseys, 18 Holsteins, 9 Ayrshires, and 6 Jerseys on parade.
