Refreshments were served to members by Society of Farm Women 15 President, Lois Johnson was in charge of the meeting.

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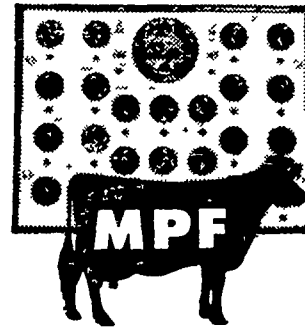
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
