- 1 package frozen sliced peaches, thawed and drained
 - 3 or 4 large strawberries, cut in halves
- Blend zwieback crumbs, softened butter or margarine and sugar. Press firmly against bottom and sides of a 9-inch spring form pan. Blend softened cream cheese, eggs,

sugar and vanilla. Pour into crust. Bake in moderate oven (375 degrees) 40 minutes. Cool. Dissolve strawberry flavored gelatin in boiling water and cool until sirupy. Arrange peach slices in a ring around edge of cake and place strawberry halves petal fashion in the center. Spoon gelatin over fruit. Chill thoroughly. Makes 10 to 12 servings.

CREAMY BUTTERSCOTCH FUDGE

- 1 6-ounce package butter-scotch moisels
 - 1 8-ounce package softened cream cheese
 - 2 cups vanilla wafer crumbs, finely rolled
 - 1 cup chopped pecans
 - 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- Melt butterscotch moisels and cream cheese together in top of double boiler over hot water. Stir cracker crumbs into butterscotch mixture. Add nuts and vanilla. Spread in an 8-inch square pan lined with wax paper. Chill. Cut into squares.

SODA BISCUITS

- 2 cups sifted all-purpose flour
 - 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
 - 1/2 teaspoon salt
 - 1/3 cup shortening
 - 3/4 cup buttermilk
