 soda and salt. Cut in shortening. Add buttermilk and blend

lightly. Turn out on lightly floured board. Knead gently

about 30 seconds. Roll or pat to ½ inch thickness. Cut with floured 2-inch cutter. Place on ungreased baking sheet. Bake in a very hot oven 450 degrees 12 to 15 minutes. Makes about 14 2-inch biscuits.

PINWHEELS Follow directions for mixing biscuits above. Roll out on a lightly floured board into a rectangle 8 x 16 inches. Brush with butter. Mix ½ cup brown sugar, firmly packed, 1 teaspoon cinnamon and ¼ cup raisins. Sprinkle over dough and roll firmly like a jelly roll, starting at the wide side. Seal edge. Cut in 1-inch slices. Place cut side up on ungreased baking sheet and bake in a hot oven 425 degrees 15 to 18 minutes. Makes 16 pinwheels.
