The Lancaster County Guernsey Breeders' Association has announced that they will offer several additional awards at their annual meeting.

James B Lefever secretary of the association said that Guernsey breeders in the county wishing to apply for any of the awards should contact him before October 15 since some of the records are hard to obtain.

In order to qualify for any of the prizes, the dairyman must be an owner of Registered Guernseys The cow undor consideration must carry a calf at least 175 days during the record period, and only 305 day DHIA records will be considered.

The awards will be for High Herd Butterfat for herds over 39 and under 30 cows, Lifetime production of both milk and fat of individual cows which have milked during the cuirent year, and the high lactation records completed during the current year for both rulk and butterfat These awards will be made to two year olds, three year olds, and cows four years old and open Application for any of the


