### Guernsey Ass'n Plans Additional Annual Awards

The Lancaster County Guernsey Breeders' Association has announced that they will offer several additional awards at their annual meeting.

James B Lefever secretary of the association said that Guernsey breeders in the county wishing to apply for any of the awards should contact him before October 15 since some of the records are hard to obtain.

In order to qualify for any of the prizes, the dairyman must be an owner of Registered Guernseys The cow under consideration must carry a calf at least 175 days during the record period, and only 305 day DHIA records will be considered.

The awards will be for High Herd Butterfat for herds over 30 and under 30 cows, Lifetime production of both milk and fat of individual cows which have milked during the current year, and the high lactation records completed during the current year for both milk and butterfat. These awards will be made to two year olds, three year olds, and cows four years old and over. Application for any of the awards may be made to James B Lefever, Quarryville R3

After a barbecue chicken dinner at the Lancaster poultry Center the Berks Countians toured the feed milling operations of Miller and Bushong at Rohrerstown.

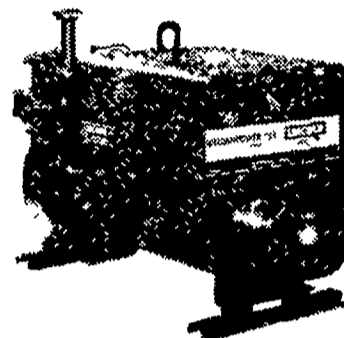
Under the direction of Reynolds Minnich, of the Rohrerstown feed firm, the group
