Garland Gingerich, teacher of vocational agriculture at Penn-Manor High School was coach of the team.

Coach of the 4-H team was Winthrop Merriam, associate county agent, who coached his charges to first place win at the state 4-H judging and demonstration days at the Pennsylvania State University in August. Hoover was first in state competition with Stoner second in individual scoring.

Maryland 4-H placed first in team scoring followed by Virginia and Pennsylvania.

The FFA championship team was from Rhode Island with New York and Connecticut in second and third place respectively.

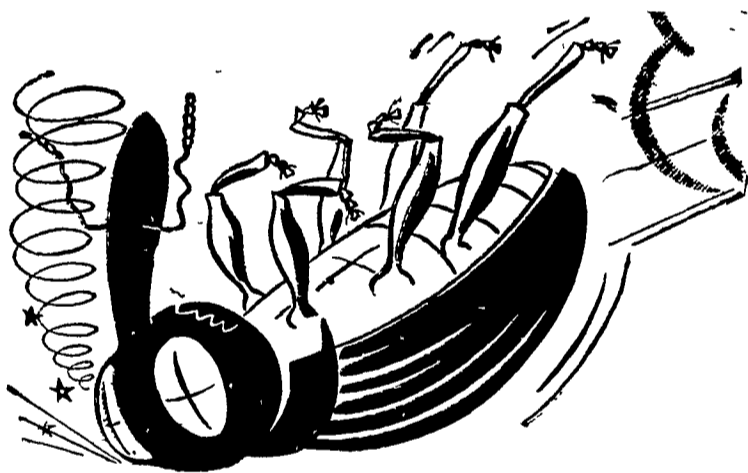

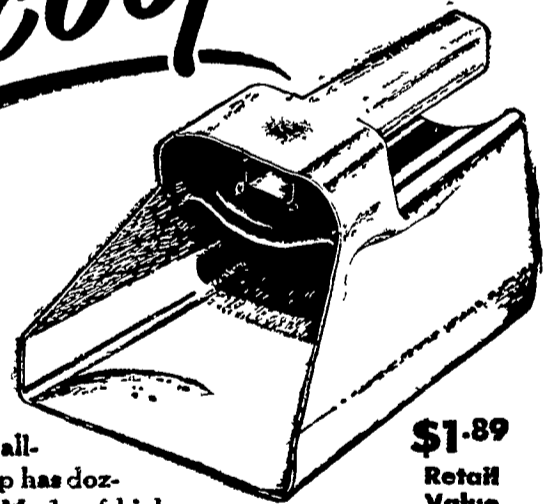
