One team of mules in the run brought \$550 Pony mares sold for \$75-125, and geldings brought \$35-100. Riding horses changed hands at \$110-400 driving horses were \$110-165, and killers brought 7 1/2 cents

The 530 hogs at the October 1 sale were 50 to 75 lower. Retail hogs at 190 to 220 lbs, went to local butchers at 19 5 to 20 75 Similar hogs to packers brought 18 85-19 50 wholesale
