

# Broilers Continue Down

Broilers continued the skid they began three weeks ago as prices dropped a cent and a half during the last week. A total of 61,000 head in 14 lots changed hands at the October 4 auction at prices ranging from 15.3 to 16.1 for a sale average of 15.4. Last week's average stood at 16.9

The high lot of broilers was a pen of 3,000 White Vantress at eight weeks, two days, consigned by William K. Burkholder and bought by Roy E. Ream.

One lot of pullets brought 25 cents for the 1,050 head, while 3,100 roasters in four lots sold for 21 to 23. Two lots of heavy fowl containing 1,450 head brought 15.1 and 15.3, and 350 leghorn fowl changed hands at 9.3.

The complete sale offered 69,990 head in 23 lots, and sold 69,950 head in 22 lots

Delmarva reported prices of 14.3 to 14.4 at farms for \$19,-600 head during the period Estimated slaughter by eastern shore processors for the week end was 744,000 head compared to the 453,000 head last week end

Te Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending September 28 was down two points from the previous week at 3.6 Broilers averaged 16.84 and mash cost the grower \$94 - 69 per ton.
