

4-H Baby Beef And Lamb Club Enrollment Deadline Nears

County Agent, M M Smith reminded boys and girls of Lancaster County this week of the enrollment period for the 4-H Baby Beef and Lamb club. Smith said, "Youths 10 to 20 years of age are eligible to feed a steer calf under the supervision of the Agricultural Extension Service."

The objectives of the program, he said, include the training and experiences of fattening a steer, the value of various feed grains, how to fit and show an animal for the show ring and the training of belonging to a group with regular meetings and educational programs.

Lancaster county has two clubs in which the youth may enroll, the county wide Red Rose Club feeds cattle for the Pennsylvania State Exposition and the State Fair Show while the New Holland club shows and sells club steers at the New Holland Fair in September each fall.

October 15 has been set as deadline for enrollment in both clubs. Interested boys and girls are urged to contact any of the following 4-H leaders: Victor Longenecker, Elizabethtown R3; Jay R Nissley, Manheim R4; J Harold Frev, Marietta R1; Melvin R Good, Manheim R1; Melvin G Rohrer, Lititz R3; Elvin Hess, Jr., Strasburg R1; and Fred Linton, Quarryville R2, for the Red Rose Club.

Enrollments can also be taken at the Agriculture Extension Office, 202 Post Office Building, Lancaster, Smith said.

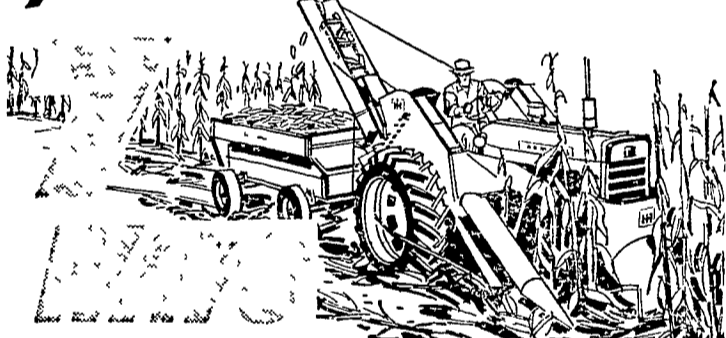
