New Holland reported a steady to strong market at the dairy cattle auction on Wednesday, October 10. The run included 156 cows, seven bulls and 19 heifers.

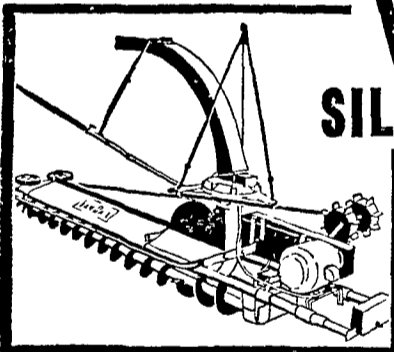
Fresh Holstein cows brought \$275-480, Guernseys, \$175-230, and other breeds \$175-285. Stock bulls brought \$110-185 and stock heifers changed hands at \$40-120.

The 200 head of horses, ponies and mules at the October 8 auction met a steady market. All mules continued to go to the killers.

Pony mares sold for \$67-100 while geldings made \$40-75. Riding horses brought \$110-160 while driving horses changed hands at \$110-185. Killers continued at 7½ cents a pound.

The October 8 hog auction had receipts of 384 head. The market was steady to 50 lower.

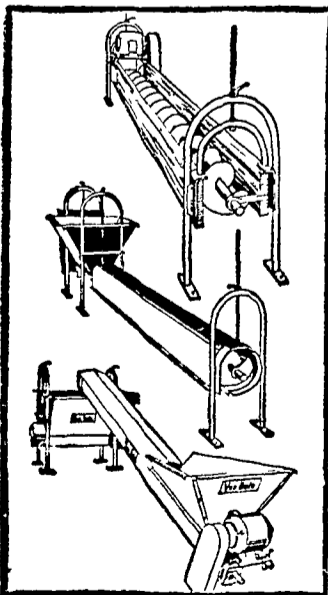

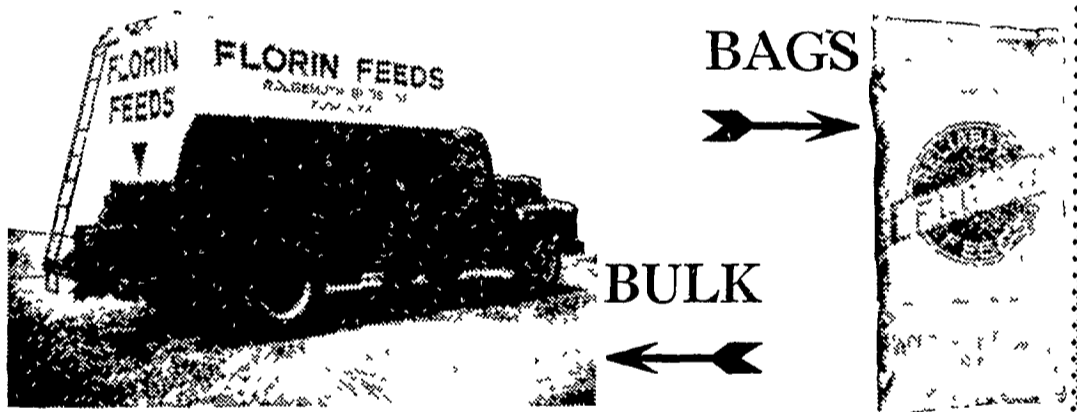
