**Pans.** Repeat with other half of dough.

Brush lightly with melted shortening. Cover; let rise until nearly double in size, about 45 minutes. Bake in a preheated moderate oven (350 degrees) about 45 minutes. Turn out of pan immediately. Makes 2 dozen buns.

**STREUSEL COFFEE CAKE**

1 10 1/2-ounce package coffee cake mix  
1 egg, unbeaten  
1/2 cup milk  
1/4 cup chopped nutmeats  
Add egg and milk to coffee cake mix. Pour batter into pan. Combine topping mix with nutmeats. Sprinkle evenly over

batter. Bake in preheated oven (375 degrees) about 25 minutes. Makes 8 servings.

**SCONES**

3 tablespoons sugar  
2 3/4 cups pancake mix  
1/2 cup shortening  
2 eggs, beaten  
1/2 cup milk

Heat oven to hot (425 degrees). Add sugar to pancake mix. Cut in shortening until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Add eggs and milk, mixing lightly until dough can be formed in a ball. (If necessary, add a little more milk to make a soft dough). Knead gently a few seconds on lightly floured board or canvas. Divide dough in half.

Roll half of dough to form a 6-inch circle. Cut into 6

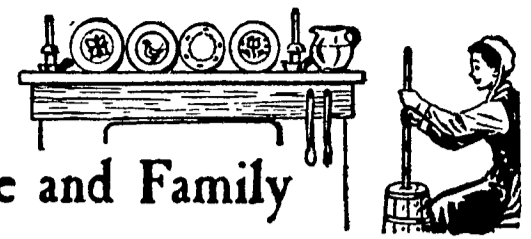
wedge-shaped pieces. Repeat with second half of dough. Place on greased cookie sheet. Brush tops with melted butter. Sprinkle with sugar. Bake in preheated oven 12 to 15 minutes. Serve hot. Makes 12 scones.

**CEREAL SUNDAE**

3 cups water  
1/4 teaspoon salt  
1/2 cup cream of wheat (quick)  
1 8 1/2-ounce can crushed pineapple, drained  
1/4 teaspoon mace  
1 pint strawberry ice cream

Bring water and salt to rapid boil. Slowly sprinkle in cream of wheat, stirring constantly while mixture thickens. Lower heat and continue

**Storing Summer Clothing**

Take stock of your dresses for needed repairs. Mend broken seams or hems and sew on loose buttons before washing or drycleaning garments. When you do this, garments will be ready for the next season.

Wash washable dresses. Be sure they are free of starch, and dry so they won't mildew during storage.

Store cottons folded flat in drawers or large storage boxes. Since they are not starched, you won't need to iron them before packing.

Have nonwashable clothing drycleaned, then hang in garment bags. You may drape heavy suits over an extra hanger to relieve strain on shoulders and waist-wool line. Hang belts separately as their weight can pull heavily on dress fabrics.

To discourage mildew, store summer wear in an area that is dry and not too warm.

Take moth preventive measures with summer clothing and bathing suits that contain
