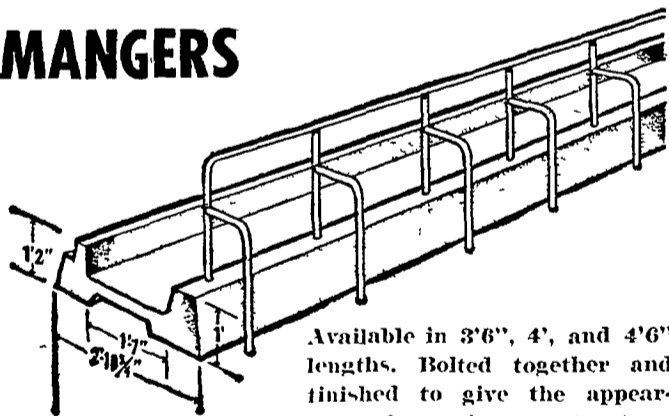

Pony mares brought \$65-100, while geldings sold for \$40-75 Riding horses changed hands at \$110-160, and driving horses brought \$110-185 Killers continued at 7 1/2 cents a pound

The 544 hogs at the October 22 auction sold at about steady prices Retail hogs weighing 190-220 pounds to local butchers brought 18 50 to 20 The
