Even cake mix cakes require some skill, reminds Louise Hamilton, Penn State extension foods specialist. The key to success with a mix is to read and follow the directions exactly as given on the package. Proper mixing and baking techniques and the right equipment are essential.

Paul B. Zimmerman Herd Tops Red Rose DHIA Fat Average

The herd of Paul B. Zimmerman, Ephrata R1, had the highest monthly butterfat average in the Red Rose Dairy Herd Improvement Association during the month of September, according to information released this week. The Zimmerman herd of 25 registered Holsteins produced an average of 57 pounds of butterfat in 1,516 pounds of milk with a test of 38 per cent.

Two herds finished the month with an average of 56 pounds of butterfat each. The 20 registered and grade Holstein cows in the herd of Amos B Lantz, Bareville R1, produced the 56 pounds of fat in an average of 1,425 pounds of milk with a 3.9 per cent test. Amos M Lapp, Kinzers R1, milked an average of 1,377 pounds of milk with a 4.1 per cent test from each of his 24 registered Holsteins.

A Holstein cow in the herd of Furry Frey, 1343 Gypsy Hill Road, Lancaster completed the high 305 day lactation record during the month. The cow, Walker, produced 874 pounds of butterfat in 21,086 pounds of milk with a 4.1 per cent test.

The second high lactation record was posted by Judy, a registered Holstein cow in the herd of John S Shelly, Mannheim R1. She made 849 pounds of butterfat in 21,737 pounds of milk with a 3.9 per cent test.

One other cow in the asso-

ciation made more than 800 pounds of fat during her lactation ending during the month. A grade Holstein in the herd of Meivm Nissley produced 848 pounds of butterfat in 22,091 pounds of milk with a 3.8 per cent test.

Four other cows made over 750 pounds of fat; they were in the herds of Furry Fred, J. Robert Hess, Paul E. Nissley and Vincent H Hoover. Sixteen other cows made between 700 and 750 pounds of fat during the year.

In the herd averages, 10 other herds had 50 or more pounds of fat per cow and another 19 herds had between 45 and 49 pounds each.

Exercise Cows

Cows need exercise even in winter, says Harvey E Shaffer, Penn State extension dairy specialist. Plans for taking care of cows during the winter should include an exercise lot convenient to the barn.
