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mixture onto waxed paper into 6 balls. Push several cubes of Cheddar cheese into center of each ball. Meanwhile prepare Fricassee.

Ham Fricassee

¼ cup (½ stick) butter
2 cups diced, cooked ham
1 cup chopped onion
1 cup chopped green pepper
2 cups bouillon or stock
1 cup milk
⅛ teaspoon crushed rosemary
Dash of pepper
Dash of nutmeg
1½ cups diced Cheddar cheese
3 tablespoons flour

In a large saucepan or pot, melt butter. Saute ham, onion and green pepper until lightly browned. Add bouillon, milk, rosemary, pepper and nutmeg. Simmer about 5 minutes. Drop dumpling mixture by spoon into simmering Fricassee, cover and cook over medium heat about 15 minutes. Remove dumplings to a warm casserole. Stir Cheddar cheese into Fricassee until melted. Add flour and cook, stirring constantly, until thickened. Pour over dumplings and serve immediately.

SWEET AND SOUR FRIED POTATOES

½ cup butter
½ cup chopped onion
¾ cup chopped green pepper
3 pounds potatoes, cooked and sliced
2 teaspoons salt
¼ teaspoon black pepper

¼ cup vinegar
1 tablespoon water
2 teaspoons sugar
1 teaspoon dry mustard
Saute onion and green pepper in butter. Add potatoes, sprinkle with salt and pepper. Brown potatoes slowly turning occasionally. When browned, add vinegar mixed with water, sugar and dry mustard. Serve warm to 6.

This an' That

A well-flavored cream sauce is a basic in all good cooking. Its creamy texture and bland flavor makes it an ideal base for dozens of dishes, including soups, main dishes, and vegetables. Milk, one of the major ingredients in a cream sauce, contributes essential nutrients to the dish in which it's used.

Enhance your savory meat stew with a topping of parsley pinwheels. Roll out biscuit dough to a rectangle, brush with melted butter, sprinkle with chopped parsley. Roll up like a jelly roll and cut in slices. Place the slices — cut side up — on top of the hot stew and bake until biscuits are crusty brown.

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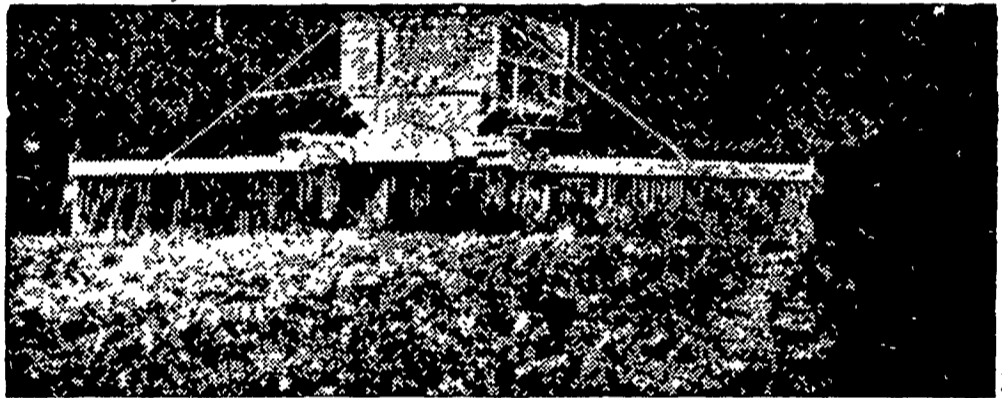
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
