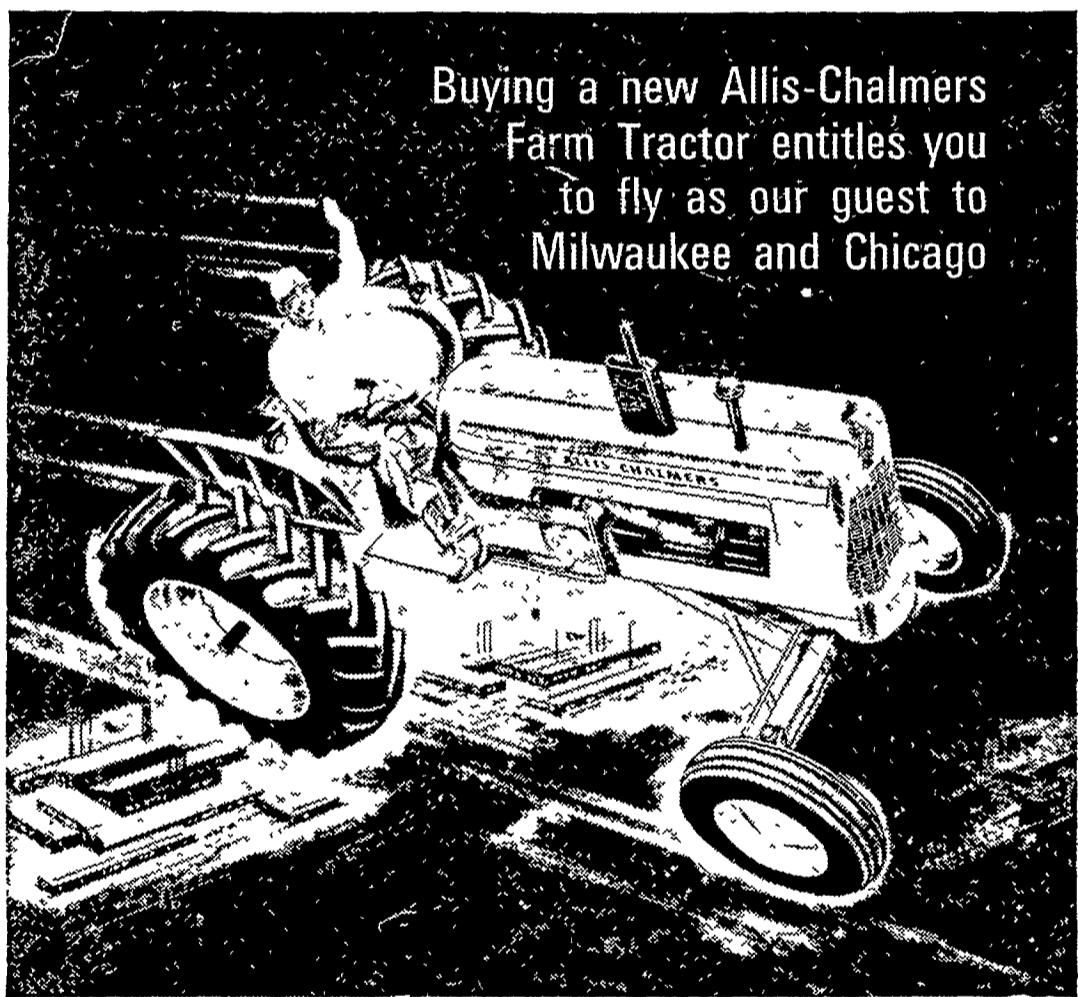
Stock bulls crossed the block at \$110-175 while stock heifers brought \$40-100
