but not dry. Fold in crumbs mixture. Drop by level table-spoonfuls, 2 inches apart, onto greased baking sheets Bake in slow oven (325 degrees) about 15 minutes or until set and lightly browned. Makes about 3 dozen cookies

**BUTTER-NUT SNOWBALLS**

(a rich, crispy cookie)

- 2 sticks (1 cup) butter
- ½ cup sugar
- 2 teaspoons vanilla
- 2 cups sifted flour
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 2 cups finely chopped pecans

Powdered sugar

Cream butter, sugar and vanilla until fluffy Sift flour with salt and add to the cream-ed mixture, blending thorough-ly Add pecans and mix well Shape into 1-inch balls and place on baking sheet. Bake in a slow oven (325 degrees)

about 20 minutes... Do not brown. Cool; then roll in pow-dered sugar.

**COCOA-NUT BALLS:** Add ¼ cup cocoa to recipe for But-ter-Nut Snowballs Bake as directed Makes about 6 dozen.

**DESSERT COOKIES**

- 2½ cups sifted flour
  - 1 teaspoon salt
  - 1 cup (2 sticks) butter
  - ¾ cup sugar
  - 2 tablespoons grated orange rind
  - 1 tablespoon grated lemon rind
  - 2 well beaten eggs
  - 1 cup shredded coconut
- Sift flour and salt together Cream butter; add sugar and mix well Beat in orange and lemon rinds and eggs Add half the flour, then coconut and remaining flour Drop from a spoon onto ungreased cooky sheet bake 10 minutes in a 375 degree oven. Makes 5 dozen cookies
