any farmer willing to learn." Two of the meetings, which are open to any interested farmer, will be held on Tuesday night, January 15.

Beginning at 7:30 p.m. the New Holland chapter will meet in the Garden Spot High School agriculture room with R. Gene Daugherty in charge. Results of the chapter's corn growing contest will be discussed by a panel of members giving their cultural practices. Awards for high production will be given by business firms in the New Holland area.

At 8 p.m. the Manor chapter will meet in the Penn Manor High School agriculture room with Howard Siglin in charge. Mr. A. Robert Carlson, extension agriculture engineer from the Pennsylvania State University will discuss building, remodeling, and construction of farm buildings.

On Thursday, January 17, Joseph McGahan, teacher of vocational agriculture at Manheim Central High School will conduct the meeting in the high school agriculture room. The subject for discussion will be farm machinery adjustment and lubrication.
