bags are excellent for vegetables.

The plastic bag is popular for meat and poultry. It the air is pushed from the plastic bag and the bag pressed tightly to the meat, the meat will retain its original quality. Heavy moisture-vapor-proof papers especially prepared for frozen food packaging are also good. These papers usually

have a shiny coating on one side and are like butcher paper on the other side. Heavy

or mediumweight aluminum foil also offers good protection, especially for beef and pork. When using foil or paper, the drugstore wrap is generally the most satisfactory.
