You can tell a lot about a cut of beef just by looking, says Harold E. Neigh, extension specialist in consumer

A flavorful and juicy cut of meat will have flecks of creamy white fat throughout the lean. In the trade, this lace-like intermingling of fat with lean is referred to as marbling.

Color of the lean is a clue to the age of the animal. A bright, cherry-red color means the beef comes from a young animal. Darker, purplish-colored beef comes from an older animal, and the meat may be

less tender, explains Mr. Neigh. However, beef that has been frozen turns darker during freezing, but this color change doesn't affect quality.

Cut surfaces of bone are another guide to the age of the animal. In a young animal, the bone surface will be red and porous.

Fat is another clue to quality, the specialist points out. Look for cuts of beef that have a covering of smooth creamy white fat that is hard and brittle, not soft and oily.
