



The Agriculture Acts of 1961 and 1962 added a number of new loan authorizations to the Farmers Home Administratio i program objectives

Loan authorities were broadened to include the financing of recreational enterprises designed to help supplement family tarmers' incomes Also small towns and associations of farmers and other rural residents now may borrow funds to finance changes in land use, including development of reciea-

tional iacilities Housing acts now permit loans to rural residents to construct homes and to senior citizens to buy, build or renovate housing for themselves as well as loans to individuals, corporations and groups to build rental housing for the elderly in ruial aieas
