



WINNING TRIO IN THE MARKET SWINE show held this week by the Lancaster County Swine Producers Association were these Yorkshires shown by Parke Thomas, Beavertown, Snyder County. The grand champion of the show was from this trio. Owner of the hogs was Reno Thomas, well known breeder of Yorkshires.

Co. Swine Show Won By Breeder From Snyder Co.

Top prize in both the individual judging and pens of three at the annual show and sale of the Lancaster County Swine Producers Ass'n Wednesday, went to a Snyder County Yorkshire breeder.

A 200 pound barrow exhibited by Reno Thomas, Beavertown, took the grand championship and teamed up with two litter mates to carry off the rosette in the trio class.

The champion, shown by Parke Thomas and Ronald Harrison, was bid in by Kunzler and Co., Inc., Lancaster, at 80 cents a pound, and the two other hogs in the trio were bought by Medford Packing, Co. of Chester for 24 cents a pound.

The reserve champion, a 240 pound Hampshire shown by John Strawbridge, Stewartstown, York County, was purchased by Kunzler for 30 cents a pound. The reserve champion trio, 625 pounds of Yorkshires, was shown by Willow Glen Farm, Strasburg R1.

The 265 head of market hogs averaged 216 pounds for a total weight of 56,240 pounds of pork for which five buyers paid \$9,880.37 or an average of 17-23 cents a pound.

Judge Dwight Younk, extension livestock specialist from the Pennsylvania State University, said the show at the Lancaster Union Stockyard had

the best collection of Yorkshires he has seen in many years. Following are the placings in the show
