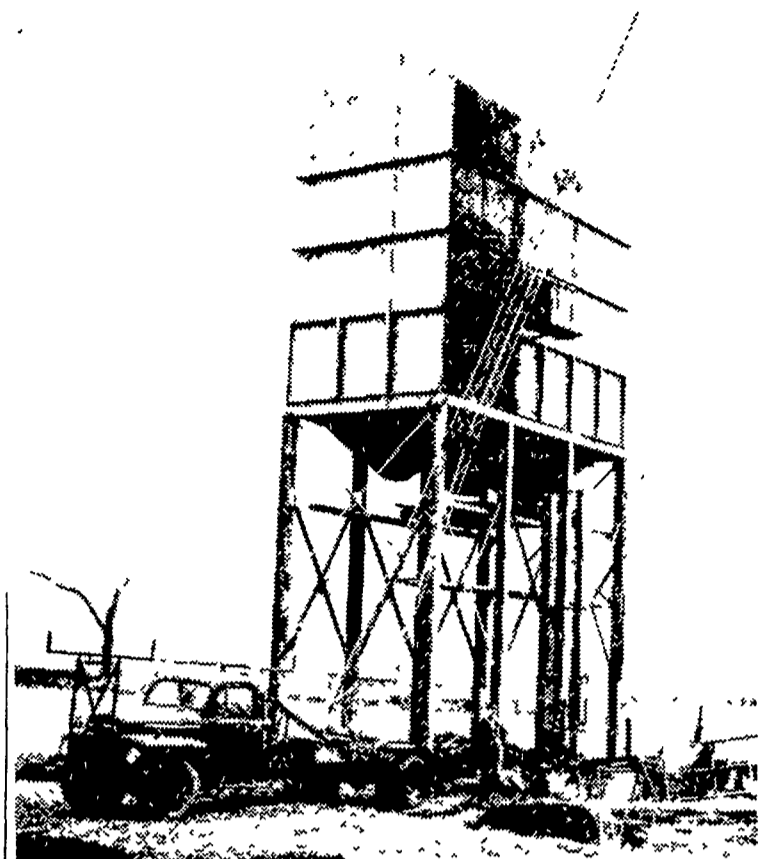
Overhead Bins For Fertilizer First In East

Lancaster County's first overhead bulk fertilizer storage bin is nearing completion at Smoketown.

When completed, the seventy feet tall structure will hold 200 tons of three different analysis fertilizers.

The plant food will be received in railroad cars and hauled to the P. L. Rohrer and Brother plant in dump trucks. It will be dumped into a pit and elevated to the bins overhead. From there gravity will take over the handling.

The fertilizer will flow into a traveling scale under the

bins and dump directly into the farmer's truck or into the firm's spreader truck. A six to nine ton truck can be loaded in less than five minutes, Wilis Rohrer said.

Weight tickets will be punched electrically avoiding errors caused by the humal element. The plant will be in operation in about a week.

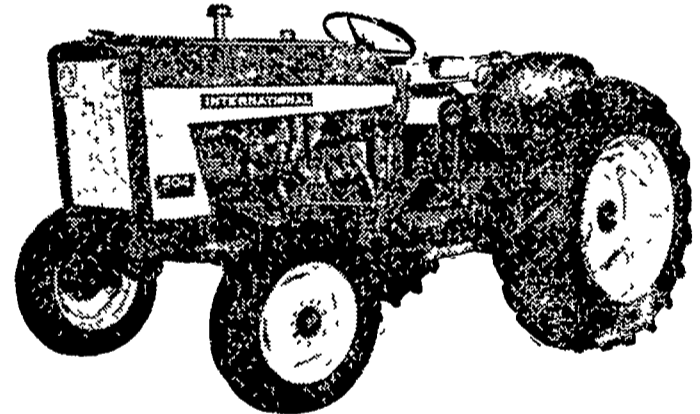
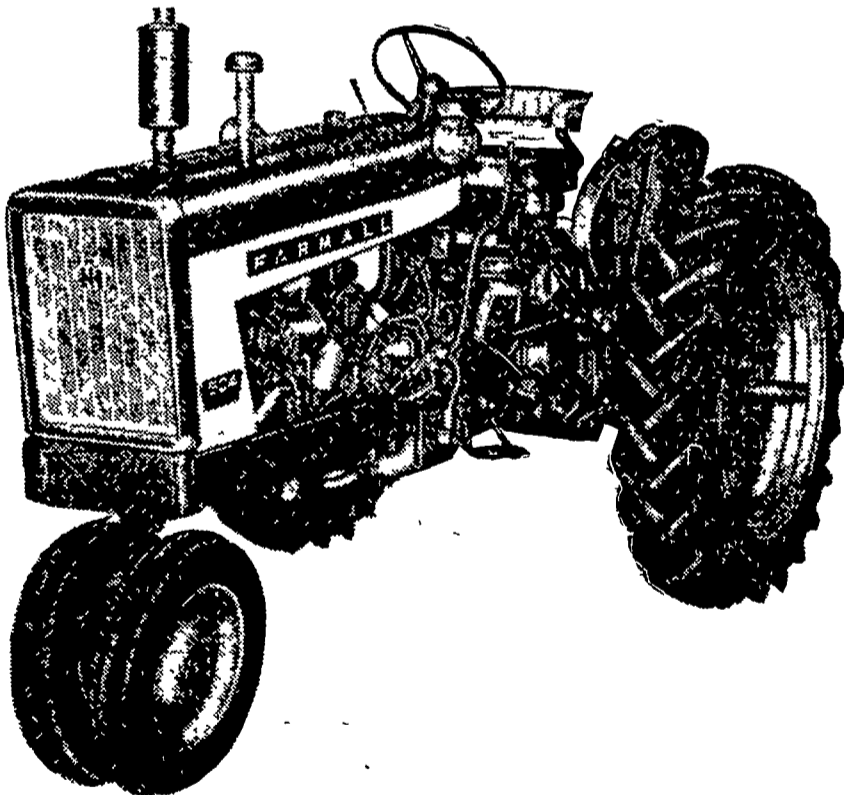
