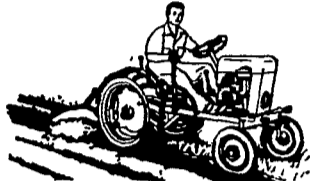
(Continued from Page 1) and have been aided also by leaders in related fields, such as management, automation and marketing

### Store Eggs

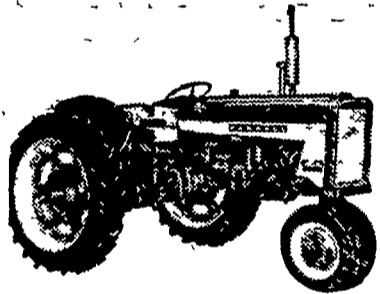
Eggs should not be stored next to strong odors such as kerosene, gasoline or any kind of oil. Eggs in the home should be kept in the refrigerator. Strong odors in the refrigerator can penetrate into eggs, says Herb Jordan, Penn State extension poultry specialist.

If you don't find turkey parts in the store where you shop, select a 15-to 25-pound frozen bird, suggests Harold Neigh, Penn State extension specialist in consumer economics. Have the bird cut in half for two 7-to 12-pound roasts or cut in quarters. Wrap the portions you won't need right away in a moisture-vaporproof material and put in your freezer.

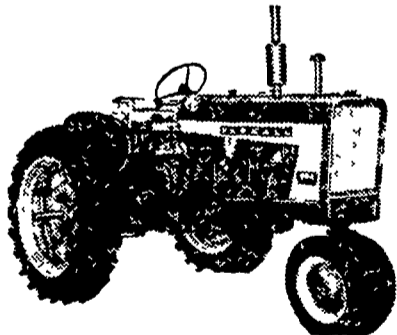

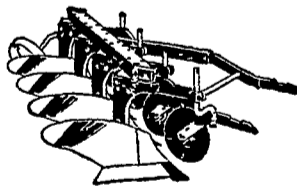

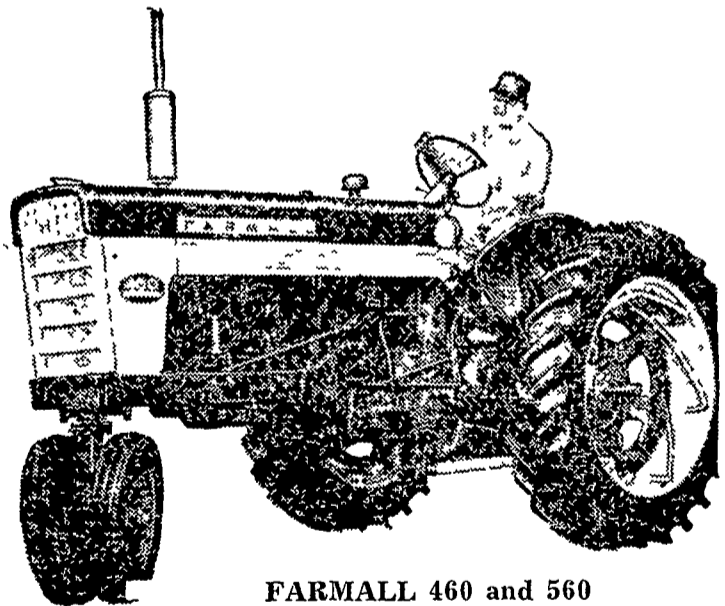
